Description of Summer Classes: The TGR-LL is offering summer classes for students who are interested in a hands-on, interactive, career-focused experience. Classes are open to students who will be entering the 6th-9th grades in Fall 2017.

Timeframe: Classes are held Monday – Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. There are three different weeks to choose from; you may register for two classes per week.

Fees: \$30 per class. Payment is due when the application is submitted. **PAYMENT MUST BE IN CASH.**

Application Process: There are three steps in the application process. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If the classes you choose are full, you will be contacted about alternative options. Classes have a limited number of spaces so it is recommended that you submit your application early. Please follow all directions and use the checklist below as you complete each step:

- Step 3: Submit application and payment by mail or drop off at the TGR-LL, D.C.
